



Wellingborough RFC Mini/Junior Rules

Wellingborough RFC ('the Club') is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. The Club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators, and parents associated with the Club should, at all times, show respect, be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the Club with the Mini/Junior Chairman in the first instance.

As a member of Wellingborough RFC, you are expected to abide by the following Mini/Junior club rules:

- All members must play within the laws of the game and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed by the coach/team manager.
- Members are encouraged to wear suitable attire following match sessions:

Club Polo Shirt (minis) or
Shirt and Club tie (Juniors)
Smart jeans/trousers

- It is not acceptable for children/young people to wear playing/training kit in the clubhouse.
- Members are required to respect club property and report any damage.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on Club premises or whilst representing the Club.
- Members are required to use correct and proper language at all times.

Alongside these, members are required to abide by the Club rules. These are displayed on the Mini/Junior notice board.
